Year 5/6 Girl's & Boy's Football





Please read the following procedures

- Please ensure your child has the correct kit and footwear to take part in their afterschool, without the correct kit children will not be allowed to take part, a PE kit or track suit and trainers or pumps.
- All afterschool clubs will finish at 4.10pm and children should be collected from the school hall at 4.15pm prompt, children cannot be collected from the corridor or stairwell.
- Children in Year 5/6 must have signed permission on their afterschool club slip to walk home from a club.
- You must inform us on the permission slip if Kidzone will collect your child from an afterschool club

Behaviour & Lateness in Clubs

Our Behaviour Policy for children in afterschool clubs is as follows:- children receive a warning letter for poor behaviour at a club, if the child's behaviour does not improve they will be removed from the club for the rest of the term, the class teacher will be informed and parents will receive a letter inviting them into school to discuss the matter, refunds will not be given if a child withdraws from a club during the term time.

A child is immediately withdrawn from a session if they use violent behaviour, they must sit in reception for the remainder of the session. The head teacher and class teacher will be informed of violent behaviour.

If a child is collected late from an afterschool club parent/carers will receive a warning letter, if the late collection continues the child will be removed from the club for the rest of the term and parent/carers will be invited into school to discuss the matter.
