4	Homework	<p>Lots of discussion had it was felt::</p> <p>A) Year 1/2 correct amount.</p> <p>B) Key stage 2 – more is needed but it needs promoting the different types of homework available e.g. study spots (these need to be communicated with the parents). The homework set in year 5/6 needs to be more of a challenge.</p> <p>Lots of discussion points came from the homework, including concerns about the history taught in school and the level of teaching in later stages of the school as felt some pupils drifted. We need to ensure that what is taught is communicated with all parents as lots of things the group was unaware was happening. Abi has spoken to Julie Forsyth and Jan Sorohan about this and we are looking at ways to inform parents of the broad and balanced curriculum offered. We also need to communicate results from year 6 more so parents can see that St Pauls has above average scores in level 5 across Literacy/science and Numeracy. We also need to inform parents what curriculum is taught in which sets as year 6 use year 7 curriculum in set 1 and often dip into year 8. Discussed that there are time constraints and lot of curriculum to cover so some of coverage of specific interest would be a role for home learning.</p> <p>C) Parents are going to come with ideas to next meeting on how to challenge pupils more with homework.</p>	Abi	Parent forum.
